

Each club sends a team of four junior golfers to play in each event. Points are awarded for participation and net scores. At the end of the year, the course with the most points wins the Foothills Interclub Trophy. These are great opportunities to meet new golfers, play other courses in the area and gain competitive experience. These events are primarily designed for juniors 13-17 with up to date Golf Canada handicaps. Those 12 and 18 years of age may play provided they help fill any empty roster spots.


PRIVATE 1 ON 1 LESSONS

Junior Coordinator, Kayde Cassidy, Assistant Professional Matt Pilon and Head Professional Jeremy Tanner are available for private 1 on 1 lessons for any junior interested. Whether it is a junior brand new to the game looking to learn the basics, or an experienced junior looking to reach the next level or mentorship in their competitive events. Kayde, Matt and Jeremy have extensive experience of all levels and can work 1 on 1 to help juniors improve their game.

Junior private lessons are discounted from regular rates.

Each lesson is 30 minutes. See below for the discounted options:

- 1 PRIVATE LESSON \$50
- 3 PRIVATE LESSONS \$135
- 5 PRIVATE LESSONS \$200



GENERAL CLUB RULES

Children

- 1. Unless permitted by the Company, children under 12 years of age are not allowed at the Club facilities unless accompanied and supervised by an adult.
- 2. Members are responsible for the conduct and safety of their children when enjoying the Club facilities.

Dress Code Golf Attire

Proper golf attire is required for all players. Proper attire shall mean the following:

- Boys Shirts with collars and sleeves and slacks or Bermuda shorts of mid-thigh length are considered appropriate attire. Tank tops, tee shirts, mesh shirts, sweat pants, warm-up suits, blue jeans, swim wear, short shorts, cut-offs, gym shorts, tennis outfits or other athletic apparel are not permitted. Baseball hats and visors should not be worn backwards or sideways at any time on the Club's premises.
- Girls Dresses, skirts, slacks, mid-length shorts, collared shirts and blouses are considered appropriate attire. Halter tops, tee shirts, cut-offs, sweat pants, warm-up suits, blue jeans, swim wear, tennis dresses, short shorts, or athletic shorts are not permitted. Baseball hats and visors should not be worn backwards or sideways at any time while on the Club's premises.
- Golf Shoes Shoes with metal spikes are not allowed at the Club.
 Shoes with soft spikes or spike- less shoes must be worn by all golfers.

Care of the Course

- Repair your divots.
- Repair your ball mark and one other on the green.
- Do not drag your feet on the greens.
- Be careful with the flagstick, set it down gently and replace it carefully. (subject to COVID protocols)
- Put your trash in the proper containers.
- Pick up broken tees.
- Keep your push carts in the proper areas which are off the tee boxes and away from the greens.
- After use, please rake the sand trap and replace the rake properly outside of the bunker. (subject to COVID protocols)

Consideration for your Fellow Golfers

- Play quickly and within the maximum time of 4 hours and 12 minutes for 18 holes.
- Keep up with the group ahead.
- Mark your scorecard on the next tee box.
- Be quiet when other players are playing their shot.
- Do not hit until the group in front of you is out of range.
- Yell "Fore" if your ball is flying towards another person.
- Golf can be dangerous if you are careless. Do not get into a position where you could be hit by a golf ball or golf club.
- According to the Rules of Golf, you may only look for a lost golf ball for 3 minutes.

- Do not be afraid to compliment your playing partner for a good shot.
- The use of foul language is prohibited.
- Golf is a game of honor.
- Cheating only hurts you.
- Smoking and drinking alcohol anywhere on the Club premises is not permitted by any junior member enrolled in The Hamptons Junior Program.
