TUESDAY LADIES DAY GAMES

(3 different tee times. 9am: no format, 3pm: with scheduled game, 5pm: 9 holes with scheduled game)

(Proximity Markers will be determined on the day of playing. Games are Subject to Change)

June 8th: Lets start the year off with a fun game! The game is called 'Here is the Kicker'. Each player gets 1 free kick on each hole. You can kick your ball out of the bunker, fairway, rough, from under a tree... (Do not take a dive into one of the ponds to search for your ball)!

June 15th: 'Low Putts'. Keep count of the number of putts you take during the round and write it down on your score card. Lowest number of putts is the winner. Drive for show... putt for dough!

June 22th: 'Mulligan Night'. It's a normal round, but each player gets 1 mulligan on the par 3's.

June 29th: 'O Canada'. 4-person team scramble with a twist! Time to step it up a bit and mix in some different distances. You will be playing both the red tees and the white tees throughout your 9 or 18 hole round. Hole 1: red Hole 2: white, repeated throughout the round. Each teammate hits their tee shot and pick the best positioned ball throughout the hole and achieve the lowest score. It is important that all players wear RED and WHITE. Best dressed wins a prize!



July 6th: 'Two-person scramble'. Teams of 2; each hitting a shot and then playing from the best positioned ball throughout the hole. This starts from the tee shot to the final putt. Take the lowest score for your team. Max number of strokes is 8. (Please pick up your ball after your 8th shot).

July 13th: 'Nothing wrong with Pink'. There is absolutely nothing wrong with playing a pink ball, but for this individual stroke play event, Player 1 starts with the pink ball, whomever has the highest score in the group must play the ball next. A sleeve of balls will be provided.

July 20th: 'Blind Partners'. Keep score and we pair you up. Low team wins!

July 27th: 'She shoots, she scores!'. Play your own ball and keep your own score but putting is important. You must avoid those dreaded 3 putts! Example: 1 putt: 3 pts 2 putt: 2pts 3+ putt: -2pts.

August 3rd: 'Getting Creative'. This is a stroke play game, but you are only allowed to use 6 clubs from your bag (including your putter). Be creative and choose the clubs that will help you score the best!

August 10th: 'That 70s show'. Why not get a little festive and head back to the 70s when times were good. Dress to impress in your best 70s attire! Best looking team wins a prize and bragging rights. 4-person team best ball.

August 17th: 'Two-person best ball'. Teams of two, play your own ball on each hole. Use the best net score of the two per hole. (Max score is 8; pick up after 8th shot)

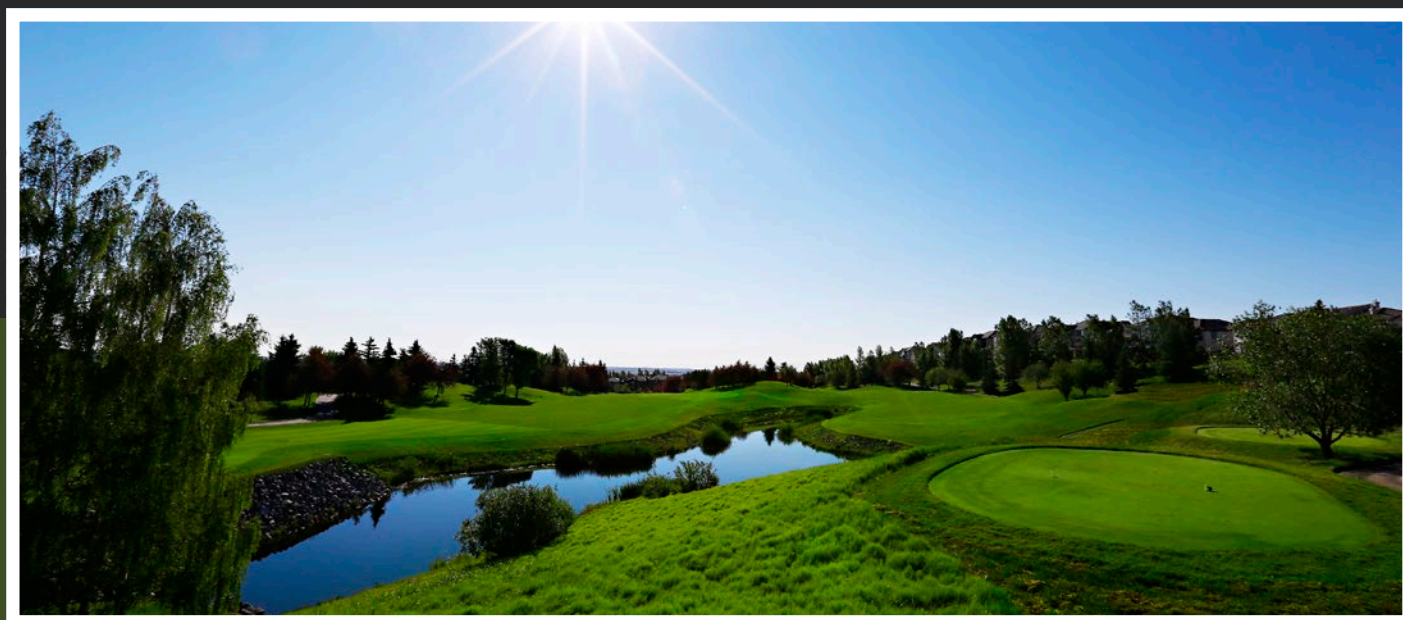
August 24th: 'Net Stableford'. Stableford is an exciting scoring format. You keep your own score throughout the round, but your scoring number is important. Example: Eagle: 4 pts Birdie: 3 pts Par: 2 pts Bogey: 1pt Double bogey or worse: 0 pts. The player with the most points wins, and your handicap will help with your overall net stableford score.

August 31st: 'Fairway finder'. Play your own ball and keep your own score but it is important to count the number of fairways you hit during the round. Each fairway hit is 2pts if you miss the fairway its -1pt. Most points at the end of the round wins.

September 7th: 'Fairway Floozies'. 3 points to hit a fairway (1st shot) then you subtract your putts. Fairway hit & 2 putts= 1 point. You can go into negative numbers!

September 14th: 'The more the merrier'. Golf can be a frustrating game sometimes but why not incorporate some fun into the frustrating times. Play your own ball and there is a point system involved for those 'frustrating' areas on the golf course. Example: Out of bounds: 1pt, water: 1pt, bunker: 1pt, 3-putt: 2pt, bunker to bunker: 2pt, 4-putt: 3pt. The player with the lowest points wins!

September 21st: It's the final countdown'. The day has come for the final Ladies League game. All the players can look back and chat about the eventful games throughout the season. This one is net stableford play but it is time for a skills challenge! Each hole will have a different skills challenge proximity marker.

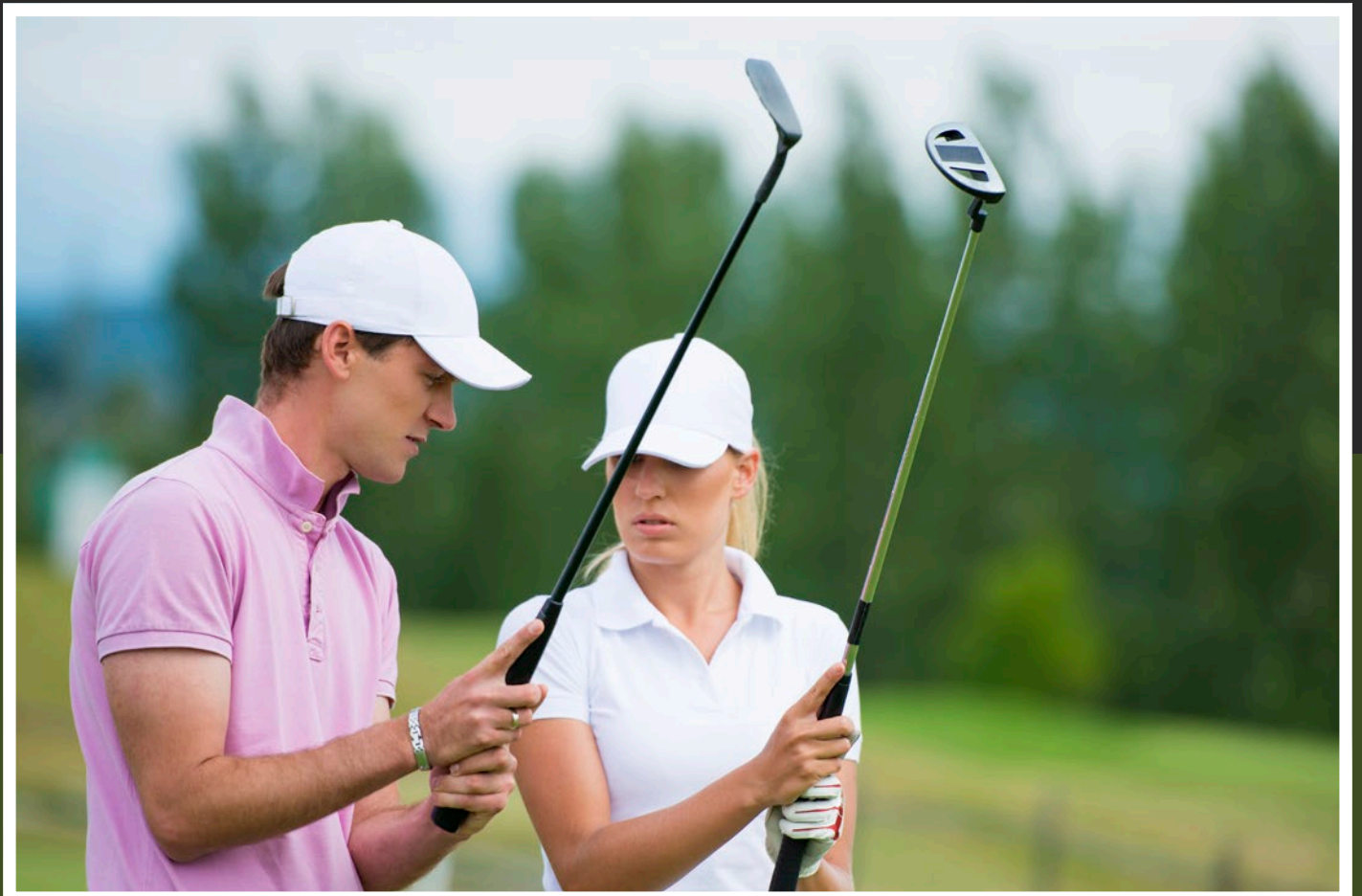


PRIVATE LESSONS
